Governor Bill Richardson Names New Judge to 2nd Judicial District Court

SANTA FE – Governor Bill Richardson has appointed Charlie Brown to fill a new judicial position in the 2nd Judicial District in Albuquerque.

Mr. Brown holds a bachelors degree in humanities from Baker University in Kansas. Brown is a 1985 graduate of the University of New Mexico School of Law.

Since 2004, Charlie Brown has been a sole practitioner in Albuquerque. Previously, Brown served as Deputy District Attorney with the 13th Judicial District and was Assistant US Attorney in Alaska for three years.

“Charlie Brown has an extensive background in criminal law, his insight and experience will be valuable to the New Mexico judicial system,” said Governor Bill Richardson.

Mr. Brown lives in Albuquerque with his wife, Marlinda Rose Aragon Brown. Charlie Brown is involved in numerous civic organizations including the New Mexico Indian Bar Association and has traveled around the country working as a faculty instructor for legal groups.

Brown will serve in the new judgeship created during the 2007 Legislature. The appointment shall be effective until the next general election in 2008.
